Master of Business Administration

Listed below is the estimated cost of attendance for a Quincy University MBA student. Each student's bill is different due to the number of credit hours, bookstore charges, and other instructional costs.

Tuition cost per MBA credit hour:	\$550.00
Graduate/Technology Fee per semester:	\$15.00 per credit hour

Along with the direct costs at Quincy University, a student should be prepared to spend approximately \$500.00 each semester for books and supplies. After the total direct costs are deducted from the total amount of student aid received, most students can allow for additional funds. These additional funds are only allowed for education-related expenses such as class-specific fees, transportation to and from classes, daycare for children while parents attend classes, and additional materials a student may need for class.
